SPELLING MATTERS!



Spelling is more important than it has ever been!
Spelling plays an important role in becoming literate as it develops

- better readers,
- fluent writers, and
- articulate speakers.

Spelling involves both phonics skills and visual memory. Some words can be approached in reading and writing through letter-sound knowledge (phonics), while others (such as who) need to be memorized. Many words need both to know the difference in meaning (wood, would).

Word knowledge that grows out of GOOD spelling instruction stays with a person all of his or her life and can be used in whatever he or she does.
