 - GVC and Learning Targets- go from preschool to 5th grade. Preschool is district wide- other grade levels come up with their own targets making them kid friendly and parent friendly. These are sent home with students at the beginning of the year.
- ✓ Testing from 2017-2018 school year
 - DIBELS assessment- Looking at the data you want to see a higher percentage in the BLUE and GREEN areas. Looking at our data, we need to improve our DIBELS scores and increase the blue and green proficient areas.
 - Action plan: Kindergarten, Second Grade, and Third Grade need to increase their scores by 10%.
 - Amy Barton brings attention to the fact that DIBELS is a screener, not necessarily an achievement assessment.

- Why are our students not achieving while others in the district are? We need to have a goal in order to increase our scores. We need to be focusing on instruction that will help improve DIBELS while still teaching the whole child.
 - There are a lot of factors that go in to the data that we are reading such as: high move in and move outs, assessment differ from BOY to EOY, etc.
- SAGE scores
 - Some increases, however our concern is science and 5th grade. 5th grade is departmentalizing this year where each teacher is teaching a subject (math, reading, and science).
- ✓ Community Walks
 - Scheduled walks through the school for members of the community. This has been done in the past.
 - Beginning of the year and End of the year
- ✓ Safe Technology and Digital Citizenship
 - Review needed for specific devices and equipment that is currently being used in our school.
 - Team leaders will be given a copy to update for their grade level
 - This packet gives detailed information on how we are monitoring and protecting students while they are using technology.
- ✓ Budget
 - Reach for Reading Program was purchased in May and has not been used with Community Council funds as previously discussed.
 - Currently we are going through our purchases and switching purchases around to open up funds for Reach for Reading.
 - We need to review and edit goal number 3 from previous year, which stated a new reading program would be purchased. As a council, we will create a goal based on the needs of the school such as classroom supplies, technology, books, etc.
