# School Trust Lands Plan 2018-2019 Coral Canyon Elementary School - FINAL REPORT

**Goal #1** Our goal is to provide quality music instruction and interaction for all students Kindergarten through 5th grade. Our goal is also to integrate core subjects into music.

Academic Areas \*Reading \*Fine Arts \*Mathematics \*Science

#### Measurements

Our music teacher has four goals for students that encompass the scope of learning:

-Sing in tune

-Keep a beat

-Properly play instruments

-Discover why you like music

These questions were given to the students to answer at the end of the year:

- 1. Do you know what our four music goals are? 55% answered yes
- 2. Do you feel like I taught them to you and made sure you learned them? 76% answered yes
- 3. Do you feel like I, or someone else, supported you to help you learn them? 70% answered yes

### Action Plan Implementation

The principal and the district arts specialist worked together to find a music teacher that could spend half of the week at Coral Canyon and half of the week at another school that wanted music integration. A music teacher was hired in May of 2018.

Our music teacher attends grade-level PLCs on a weekly, rotational basis. He spends 10-15 minutes with each grade-level. This makes it so he is planning with each grade-level approximately once every 6 weeks. (Kindergarten through 5th grade)

Expenditures:

**Goal #2** Coral Canyon Elementary will increase the number of students proficient in DIBELS by 3% from last year scores in Kindergarten, 1st grade, and 2nd grade. Coral Canyon Elementary students will meet growth (SGP) on the end-of-level test for the 2018-2019 school year in 3rd, 4th, and 5th grades.

Measurements

RISE end-of-year state assessment scores: 3rd grade Math: 47% (up 2%) 4th grade Math: 38% (down 16%) 5th grade Math: 47% (up 12%) 4th grade Science: 37% (down 12%) 5th grade Science: 61% (up 33%)

### Action Plan Implementation

Teachers continue to reflect on GVCs and improve CFAs (common formative assessments). PowerHour was used for grade-levels to intervene and extend student learning with the help of reading aides, SPED teachers, and the reading specialist. The reading specialist continues to train the reading aides on strategies and application.

Expenditures \$27,239

**Goal #3** A new reading program will be purchased for Coral Canyon Elementary.

Amendment: On October 22, 2018, the Community Council sent a letter to the Washington County School Board to amend this goal. We were no longer needing to pay for the Reach for Reading (R4R) program as the principal needed to fund the program from other sources. The Community Council decided to allocate \$3,000 for library books, specifically 5th grade teachers so they could build up their classroom novel series sets. The Council also decided to allocate \$18,000 for technology. That amendment was approved by the School Board in the November 2018 meeting.

### Action Plan Implementation

Due to the amendment, this program was not purchased. 5th grade novel sets were purchased. New chromebooks were also purchased for 4th grade students as theirs were out of date and no longer compatible with software and state testing programs.

Expenditures: \$1,877 novel series sets \$25,616 technology devices and upkeep
