## Goal #1 – STREAM Learning & Activities

Students LOVE STREAM days! Our STREAM committee consists of one teacher from each grade level, a parent volunteer, our Title I Coordinator (Mr. Nelson), and a teacher from SPED. This committee meets minimally once a month to determine activities for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Friday STREAM Day each month. The committee gets feedback from students and staff, either pros and cons of the previous activity or ideas for future activities. Those things are discussed at the monthly meetings. Feedback is essential in planning future activities and determining the success of STREAM Days.

We are also 1:1 chromebooks in grades 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup>, with 8-14 iPads per classroom school-wide. Students are using chromebooks and/or iPads on a daily basis for reading, math, and science activities and research. The school has also purchased 12 new LEGO kits to be used next school year. There are also plans to have a STREAM Parent Night next school year.

## Goal #2 – Reading Fluency & Proficiency

The school purchased the Benchmark Assessment System (BAS) for Kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup>, and 2<sup>nd</sup> grades. Our Reading Specialists have already been using this as a diagnostics test three times/year. Purchasing these kits now allows teachers the opportunity to perform these same assessments on all students and have the same words and language across all lower-grades. Reading Specialists and our reading aides work four days/week in small groups with students.

Our Take-home Librarian and our Leveled Librarian work each day to ensure books are ready for students and teachers.

All DIBELS scores increased in Kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> grades!

SAGE scores went down in upper-grades. The principal has met with individual teachers and grade-level teams to look at data and make plans for improvement. Grades are focusing on deeper GVCs and Learning Targets, ensuring high levels of learning for all students.
