From the Reading Specialist:

There is such joy and value in reading aloud to children of all ages and they are never too old!

Reading to your child provides quality time spent together. This can spawn discussions around what's happening and the reactions you are both feeling. Opportunities may develop to discuss new vocabulary and make connections to themselves or the world. It's a chance to hear literary language which is quite different from the way we talk, but will provide a foundation for their own reading as they grow into more difficult books.

Title I Notes:

Coral Canyon is a Title I school which means we receive additional funding (Federal Funds) for various programs that you may not see at a regular school. Some of these programs funded by Title I that you will find at our school are:

- All-day kindergarten for children who qualify
- Preschool
- Free and reduced lunch and breakfast
- Small group and individual tutoring
- Quality computer instruction available at school and home

Title I is a federal program that is designed to

- Help students achieve academic success
- Increase student performance
- Build teacher quality through professional development
- Enhance parents' abilities through quality parental involvement activities.

Title I status is determined by the number of students who qualify for free and reduced lunch. In our district the schools with the highest numbers receive this federal support. It is important that we have as many people apply for this as possible so we can maintain these programs.
